Terms and Conditions

1. General information

Airis Films Wedding Videographer will provide services to the Customer(s), providing the Customer(s) have/has assessed all the risks that may occur.

2. Booking and payment

a. A date will only be considered reserved once the booking Deposit (50%) is paid. The final 50% is due to be paid before the day of the filming or within the week after filming.

3. Cancellations

a. The Customer(s) may cancel this booking at any time by giving written notice

b. Full Refunds are only available if it is informed in writing to AirisFilmsWeddings@gmail.com no longer than 72hours after booking the dates. In the event of later cancellation Airis Films Wedding Videographer releases the dates and if successful 25% will be refunded.

c. The Customer(s) must obtain permission to film the Marriage Service and the Customer(s) is also responsible for any fees levied at the various locations.

d. The Customer(s) must also seek permission from any other venue where filming will be required.

d. Arrangements should be made for all venues to be accessible by Airis Films Wedding Videographer at least one hour before the time of each event; this is to be arranged by the Customer(s).

Every effort is made to ensure perfect colour and lighting reproduction, but certain conditions may not be accurate such as mixed indoor and external lighting, hard shadows, and low lighting conditions. With these factors beyond our control, we will endeavour to produce the best image possible. In the case that a particular segment of the event is either not recorded, partially recorded, or not a part of the final edited film, it is at the sole discretion of Airis Films Wedding Videographer. If something occurred at the wedding that the Client does not want to appear on the final film, the Client must instruct Airis Films Wedding Videographer in writing before post-production begins.

4. Food

If video coverage is greater than 4 hours, the Client must provide a hot meal to the camera operative. It is very important that this be served at the same time as any other food is served to guests.

5. The Edit

- a. Airis Films Wedding Videographer will endeavour to build your film around any special requests made, but such requests are not binding instructions. Artistic interpretation cannot be guaranteed but every attempt will be made to comply with the Customer(s) wishes.
- b. Completion is usually within 1 - 4 months from the date of the event (not including any bank holidays).

6. Ownership of the Master Footage and Copyright

- a. The master Footage remains my property. Copyright in the master footage is vested in me. This means that:
 - b. I reserve the right to dispose of the master footage at my absolute discretion.
 - c. I do not accept liability in relation to any loss of and/or damage to the master footage.
 - d. Neither you nor any one on your behalf are allowed to make any copies of any footage, digital copies or other recorded media unless we have agreed that you may do so. Please note that the copying of footage without my consent is a breach of copyright for which you may be liable in damages

7. Master Footage is kept for a period of one year.

- a. After you have received your copy of the films I reserve the right to use the films or part of it to any prospective client who may wish to see a sample of my work, or to enter it into competitions, use extracts in our showreel or display online, unless agreed otherwise. Airis Films Wedding Videographer will seek for permission before using the footage in public domain.

8. In case Airis Films Wedding Videographer is unable to make it to the wedding, Airis Films Wedding Videographer will do his best to find a replacement for the day.

9. Additional

- a. I keep a master copy of your film in our archives for up to one year. You may order additional copies within this period as required. If you wish to order additional copies after one year we cannot guarantee that the master will be available.
